## What is Little Heroes of Inclusion about?

Children play an essential role in creating inclusive preschool environments, and by extension, an inclusive Singapore. The Good Start SG movement aims to raise children who are exemplars to others (both children and adults alike), hence the Little Heroes of Inclusion campaign.

### The Award

As part of the campaign, we invite preschools in Singapore to nominate children who have been exemplars of inclusive practices. This is an annual effort to recognise and encourage them. Awards will be given out during the annual Good Start Conference. Through the award, we hope that they will inspire others to learn, play, contribute and participate meaningfully alongside their typically developing peers in the classroom and the community.

### **About Good Start SG**

The Good Start SG movement is borne both out of a desire to respond to the government's call for more inclusion and inclusive practices in Singapore and also of a restless spirit to effect change in areas where gaps in the sector are observed. This movement was started by practitioners who desire to bring everyone together to create a community of practice that equips, supports and advances inclusion in preschools.

Part of our effort to build a community of practice that equips, supports and advances inclusion in preschools is the organising of the annual Good Start Early Childhood Conference. Each year, our Conference aspires to bring in presenters who are expert practitioners their field to equip Conference attendees with practical handles that they can immediately apply with some modifications at work (or at home for parents).

- Finding ways to help them access learning
- Inspiring others to come alongside to care for them
